

MORE THAN WE IMAGINED

Report: Year One, Central Park Church of Christ

Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, to him be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever. Amen.

Ephesians 3:20, 21

It's hard to believe a year has gone by already! In these past twelve months God has worked powerfully among us and truly has done more than we could ask or imagine. Every goal we put before our Lord has been exceded and every plan we've prayed about has succeeded. All this is to God's glory who blesses his people every where as they proclaim his word.

The Central Park Church of Christ first met on May 29, 1983 when nine people had a simple service in a studio apartment on Park Avenue. A contribution of \$247.00 was offered and the entire congregation fit on an elevator! Three days later we had our first baptism and during that week a total eighteen Christians committed themselves to the task of beginning a congregation in "the Big Apple." The second Sunday the church met (the first service we ever had in the 76th and Central Park West address where we now meet), 37 people were in attendance and the contribution was \$552.00. Since that time our attendance has grown to over 180 on Sundays and our contribution is over \$2,500.00 per week. One year ago we had three group Bible studies, all in Manhattan. Now there are nineteen, scattered throughout three boroughs, three counties, and two states. We began with two Bible talk leaders. Now there are twelve.

Most exciting, of course, have been the additions the Lord has made to the church. Our goal was to have 60 baptisms our first year and to God's glory 61 were baptized into Christ! The goal that is yet before us, to have 100 new conversions this year, is too great for us, but we have a God who can do more than we imagine!

When we began we set a goal to be self-supporting by the end of the first year of the ministry, with an optimistic plan to accomplish this task early-by February 1984. We were able to announce even earlier than that, January 15, that we were a self-supporting congregation!

Our special contribution in February, a goal set at \$4,000.00, which was to help us as a newly self-supporting church, was even exceded. Over \$8,500.00 was given when every member of the church sacrificially gave for the purpose of building a congregation that will fill this metropolitan area with the teachings of Jesus!

And when we began one year ago, we were reaching out to only one college campus. Now we have ministries on four different campuses, having had 40 students baptised this year.

I believe God wants us to be confident and bold as we begin this second year of our ministry. The need of the hour is to see families won for Christ. We have been blessed during this first year with numerous families who have placed membership with us. Together we will see our Lord work in the hearts of husbands, wives, and children as we continue to labor together.

And with addition of Mike Taliaferro as evangelist, another goal God blessed us with, and Ann Yarri as intern, what will we accomplish through God's power this next year?
